Workshop with Mark Wolynn

The specific focus of this weekend will be on illness and the effect of the family system as a contributing factor to disease or symptom presentation.

In this workshop, participants uncover the dynamics in their family systems that contribute to illness, depression, panic attacks, constant worry, failed relationships and financial failure. Family Constellation work originally developed by Bert Hellinger is an effective therapeutic process that helps to break destructive family patterns of unhappiness, illness, failure and addiction. The results are often immediate and life-changing.

Mark Wolynn is the Director of The Hellinger Institute of Western PA and the Co-Director of The Hellinger Learning Center in NYC. He conducts trainings in family systems therapy throughout the USA, England, Canada, Latin America, and for the University of Pittsburgh's Graduate School of Social Work's Continuing Education Program.
